Economically Active Population Survey in May 2022

The economically active population marked 29.374 million persons in May, which grew 676 thousand persons or 2.4% year-on-year.
○ The labor force participation rate stood at 64.9% in May, up 1.2%p year-on-year.
<employed and="" employment="" persons="" population="" ratio="" to=""></employed>
The number of employed persons totaled 28.485 million persons in May, which went up 935 thousand persons or 3.4% year-on-year.
○ The employment to population ratio recorded 63.0% in May, up 1.8%p year-on-year.
<unemployed and="" persons="" rate="" unemployment=""></unemployed>
The number of unemployed persons totaled 889 thousand people in May, which decreased 259 thousand persons or 22.5% year-on-year.
○ The unemployment rate marked 3.0% in May, down 1.0%p year-on-year.

○ The economically inactive population totaled 15.871 million people in May, decreasing 480 thousand persons or 2.9% year-on-year.
