## Economically Active Population Survey in June 2022

<ul> <li>The economically active population marked 29.366 million persons in June which grew 636 thousand persons or 2.2% year-on-year.</li> </ul>
○ The labor force participation rate stood at 64.9% in June, up 1.2%p year-on-year
<employed and="" employment="" persons="" population="" ratio="" to=""></employed>
The number of employed persons totaled 28.478 million persons in June, which went up 841 thousand persons or 3.0% year-on-year.
○ The employment to population ratio recorded 62.9% in June, up 1.6% year-on-year.
<unemployed and="" persons="" rate="" unemployment=""></unemployed>
<ul> <li>The number of unemployed persons totaled 888 thousand people in June, which decreased 205 thousand persons or 18.7% year-on-year.</li> </ul>
○ The unemployment rate marked 3.0% in June, down 0.8%p year-on-year.

○ The economically inactive population totaled 15.882 million people in June decreasing 456 thousand persons or 2.8% year-on-year.
